A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation for various state programs to
 2 the Herbert Hoover birthplace foundation, Mississippi River
 3 parkway commission, midwest nuclear compact, Iowa American
 4 revolution bicentennial commission, Iowa state fair board,
 5 agricultural societies, Iowa development commission, and
 6 Iowa dairy industry commission.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and
3 ending June 30, 1977 the following sums, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

6 Incorporated
7 For support, maintenance and miscellaneous
8 purposes.....\$ 2,730
9 2. Mississippi River Parkway Commission
10 For support, maintenance and miscellaneous

5 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
6 of the agencies receiving funds under this Act are appropriated
7 for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

8 EXPLANATION

9 Section one of this Act appropriates funds to the Herbert
10 Hoover Birthplace Foundation, the Mississippi River Parkway
11 Commission, the Midwest Nuclear Compact, the Iowa American
12 Revolution Bicentennial Commission, the Iowa State Fair Board,
13 agricultural societies, and the Iowa Development Commission.
14 These appropriations provide for existing programs at present
15 levels.

16 Section two permits the Iowa dairy commission to expend
17 \$48,000 from the dairy industry fund to operate their office.
18 The remainder of the fund, which is derived from dairy checkoff
19 revenue, is appropriated to pay refunds and for promotional
20 expenses and research.

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR VARIOUS STATE PROGRAMS TO THE HERBERT HOOVER BIRTHPLACE FOUNDATION, MISSISSIPPI RIVER PARKWAY COMMISSION, MIDWEST NUCLEAR COMPACT, IOWA AMERICAN REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION, IOWA STATE FAIR BOARD, AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES, IOWA DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, AND IOWA DAIRY INDUSTRY COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

1. Herbert Hoover Birthplace Foundation,
Incorporated
For support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$ 2,730
2. Mississippi River Parkway Commission
For support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$ 6,000
3. Midwest Nuclear Compact
For dues to the Midwest Nuclear Compact.....\$ 10,853
4. Iowa American Revolution Bicentennial
Commission
For salaries and support of not more than four permanent full-time positions, and maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$ 65,300
5. Iowa State Fair Board
For maintenance of buildings and grounds.....\$ 75,800
For premiums.....\$ 10,000
6. Agricultural Societies (local fairs)
 - a. For state aid.....\$ 210,000
 - b. The appropriation for state aid to agricultural societies is conditional on full compli-

ance with all other statutes which regulate and prescribe the conditions under which such aid is payable. In no case shall any county receive more than two thousand one hundred (2,100) dollars, except that in a county where there are two definitely separate county extension offices, each such society shall receive state aid in such amount as it would be entitled to if it were the only society in the county. In counties having more than one fair entitled to state aid, the state aid available for the county shall be prorated to the fairs on the basis of cash premiums paid by the fairs.

7. Iowa Development Commission

a. For salaries and support of not more than forty-seven permanent full-time positions, and maintenance, promotion and miscellaneous purposes.....\$1,564,913

b. The Iowa development commission shall allocate from funds appropriated by paragraph a of this subsection not to exceed thirty thousand (30,000) dollars for the seven regional tourism districts, not to exceed four thousand five hundred (4,500) dollars per district, if the district which will receive such funds provides on a dollar-to-dollar matching basis funds equal to the amount allocated by the Iowa development commission. Application for aid under this paragraph shall be made to the Iowa development commission in a manner determined by the commission.

c. For the establishment and operation of a foreign trade and development office.....\$ 50,000

Sec. 2. Section one hundred seventy-three point twelve (173.12), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

173.12 SALARY OF TREASURER. The treasurer shall receive such compensation for his services as the board may fix, not

to exceed five hundred dollars a year, and ~~necessary-traveling and-hotel-expenses~~ shall be paid a forty dollar per diem and shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred while engaged in official duties.

Sec. 3.

1. There is appropriated from the dairy industry fund to the Iowa dairy industry commission under chapter one hundred seventy-nine (179) of the Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

2. The remainder of the dairy industry fund is appropriated to be used to pay refunds as provided by chapter one hundred seventy-nine (179) of the Code and to pay promotional and research expenses deemed appropriate by the dairy industry commission.

Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies receiving funds under this Act are appropriated for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the Acts of the Sixty-third General Assembly, 1970 Session, chapter one thousand two hundred

eighty-six (1286), section five (5), chapter twenty-eight H (28H), of the Code, is repealed effective July 1, 1977.
