A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the appropriation of funds to legislative
2 agencies and making appropriations to agencies involved
3 in the legislative process.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary to the following legislative agencies and the commission on uniform state laws:

Sec. 2. Section two point fifty-nine (2.59), subsection three (3), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3. ~~He shall employ~~ Employing, with the approval of the legislative council or its chairman, such temporary employees as may be required to provide research and bill drafting services prior to and during sessions of the general assembly. Such employees shall be under the supervision of the director and shall be paid from ~~the appropriation made for the general assembly pursuant to section 2.72~~ funds appropriated to the bureau.

Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

EXPLANATION

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1. Legislative Fiscal Bureau. This appropriation in the amount of \$218,900 funds salaries, support and maintenance for the current table of organization.

2. Legislative Service Bureau. This appropriation in the amount of \$534,905 funds 28 positions on the present payroll plus 8 temporary positions being transferred from the legislative payroll to the Service Bureau.

3. Commission on Uniform State Laws. This appropriation of \$7,400 funds Iowa's assessment for participation in the amount of \$5,600 and \$1,800 for travel of the 3-member Commission.

4. Citizens' Aide. This appropriation of \$129,149 is appropriated to fund current programs. No new positions have been authorized.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary to the following legislative agencies and the commission on uniform state laws:
