1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and
3 ending June 30, 1977 the following sums, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, to be used by the following agencies
5 for the purposes designated:

2 Sec. 2. Section twenty-nine A point twenty-nine (29A.29),
3 Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

4 29A.29 PAYMENT FROM TREASURY. When in active state
5 service, the compensation of officers and enlisted men and
6 expenses of the national guard and claims for death, injury
7 and illness of the members thereof, incurred in line of duty,
8 shall be paid out of any funds in the state treasury not
9 otherwise appropriated. However, if funds for compensation
10 and expenses have been appropriated for compensation and
11 expenses of persons on full-time active state service pursuant
12 to a specific Act of the general assembly, such persons shall
13 be paid from funds appropriated pursuant to such Act.

14 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
15 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are
16 appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants
17 or receipts.

18 EXPLANATION

19 The appropriation to the Iowa state commerce commission
20 is intended to fund the program at the current level with
21 an allowance for inflation. The utilities division is
22 encouraged to reallocate several of the vacant positions in
23 order to employ an economist and pipeline inspection personnel
24 that were requested.

25 The appropriation to the department of public defense is
26 intended to fund the program at the current level with an
27 allowance for inflation.

28 The appropriation to the military division in paragraph
29 b of subsection two of section one of this Act includes funds
30 for the members of the military division who are on full-time
31 active state service. Normally funds are appropriated for
32 these persons pursuant to the unlimited appropriation
33 authorized by section 29A.29. The Committee on Appropriations
34 is providing for a specific budgeted amount for persons on
35 full-time active state service. Section 29A.29 is amended
36 to reflect such action.

1 Amend House File 1081 as follows:
2 1. Page 2, after line 13 by adding the follow-
3 ing new section:
4 "Sec. 3. Salaries of employees of agencies
5 appropriated funds under this Act as they exist on
6 June 30, 1976 shall be increased by five percent
7 rounded to the nearest dollar amount divisible by
8 twenty-six to provide for a cost of living adjust-
9 ment. This section shall not apply to employees for
10 whom the general assembly specifically provides a
11 salary rate.
12 There is appropriated from the general fund of
13 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976
14 and ending June 30, 1977, the sum of \$128,610, or
15 so much thereof as is necessary to carry out the
16 provisions of this section."

7 Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. Chapter twenty-nine (29),
8 Code 1975, is hereby repealed effective July 1, 1981.
9 Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. A representative of the
10 boards and commissions abolished by sections four
11 (4) and five (5), of this Act, shall appear before
12 the appropriate committees of the house and senate
13 upon call by the respective committee chairs prior
14 to January 30 of the year that the board or commission
15 is to be abolished. The committees may recommend to
16 their respective houses that the effective date of
17 abolishment of the boards and commissions be
18 extended."

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FUNDING OF THE IOWA STATE COMMERCE COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC DEFENSE AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used by the following agencies for the purposes designated:

However, if section two (2) of this Act does not become law, this paragraph is void. The amount set for any cost of living adjustment provided by the general assembly for employees of the state shall not apply to persons subject

to this paragraph, however funds appropriated for salary adjustments may be expended for adjusting the salaries of persons subject to this paragraph if the funds provided in this paragraph are not sufficient for such purpose.

c. Civil defense division

For salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes90,750

Sec. 2. Section twenty-nine A point twenty-nine (29A.29), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

29A.29 PAYMENT FROM TREASURY. When in active state service, the compensation of officers and enlisted men and expenses of the national guard and claims for death, injury and illness of the members thereof, incurred in line of duty, shall be paid out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated. However, if funds for compensation and expenses have been appropriated for compensation and expenses of persons on full-time active state service pursuant to a specific Act of the general assembly, such persons shall be paid from funds appropriated pursuant to such Act.

Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
