4 watchmaking, landscape architecture, and real estate.

1 Amend House File 1082 as follows:
2 1. Page 1, by adding after line 24 the follow-
3 ing new section:
4 "Sec. 2. Salaries of employees of agencies
5 appropriated funds under this Act as they exist on June
6 30, 1976 shall be increased by five percent rounded
7 to the nearest dollar amount divisible by twenty-six
8 to provide for a cost of living adjustment. This
9 section shall not apply to employees for whom the
10 general assembly specifically provides a salary rate.
11 There is appropriated from the general fund
12 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
13 1976 and ending June 30, 1977, the sum of \$8,655,
14 or so much thereof as is necessary to carry out the
15 provisions of this section."

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and
 3 ending June 30, 1977 to the following boards and commissions
 4 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
 5 to be used for the following purposes:

 7 For salaries, support, maintenance and

25 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 26 of the agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated
 27 for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

28 EXPLANATION

29 The appropriation to the board of accountancy is to support
 30 the board's current programs which consist of administering
 31 exams to applicants, certifying, registering and regulating
 32 resident certified public accountants as well as registering
 33 public accountants and nonresident certified public accountants
 34 who practice in Iowa, and examining, licensing and regulating
 35 accounting practitioners. The fees for examinations, licenses

1 and registration will be increased so that deposits to the
2 general fund will cover the expenses of the board.

3 The appropriation to the board of architectural examiners
4 is appropriated to support the board's current programs.
5 Fees will be increased so that deposits to the general fund
6 will cover the expenses of the board.

7 The appropriation to the board of engineering examiners
8 is appropriated to support the board's current programs.
9 Fees will be increased so that deposits to the general fund
10 will cover the expenses of the board.

11 The appropriation to the board of watchmaking examiners
12 is appropriated to carry on the current programs of the board.
13 Fees will be increased so that deposits to the general fund
14 will cover the expenses of the board.

15 The appropriation to the board of landscape architects
16 is appropriated to carry on the current programs of the board.
17 A full-time confidential secretary II position was added to
18 the table of organization. Fees will be increased so that
19 deposits to the general fund will cover the expenses of the
20 board.

21 The appropriation for the Iowa real estate commission
22 provides for the continuation of current programs. The
23 reallocation of an administrative officer I to an
24 administrative officer II, effective 7-1-76, was authorized.
25 Fees will be increased so that deposits to the general fund
26 will cover the expenses of the board.

"Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. Chapter one hundred ~~sixteen~~ (116), Code 1975, is hereby repealed effective July 1, 1980.

Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. Chapter one hundred eighteen (118), Code 1975, is hereby repealed effective July 1, 1980.

Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. Chapter one hundred fourteen (114), Code 1975, is hereby repealed effective July 1, 1980.

Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. Chapter one hundred twenty (120), Code 1975, is hereby repealed effective July 1, 1980.

Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. Chapter one hundred eighteen A (118A), Code 1975, is hereby repealed effective July 1, 1980.

Sec. 8. NEW SECTION. Chapter one hundred seventeen (117), Code 1975, is hereby repealed effective July 1, 1980.

Sec. 9. NEW SECTION. A representative of the boards and commissions abolished by sections three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7), and eight, of this Act, shall appear before the appropriate committees of the house and senate upon call by the respective committee chairs prior to January 30 of the year that the board or commission is to be abolished. The committees may recommend to their respective houses that the effective date of abolishment of the boards and commissions be extended.

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE TO REGULATORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS GOVERNING THE PRACTICES OF ACCOUNTANCY, ARCHITECTURE, ENGINEERING, WATCHMAKING, LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE, AND REAL ESTATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 to the following boards and commissions the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

1. Board of accountancy For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes	\$103,250
2. Board of architectural examiners For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes	\$29,040
3. Board of engineering examiners For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes	\$71,934
4. Board of watchmaking examiners For salary, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes	\$ 9,324
5. Board of landscape architectural examiners For salary, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes	\$18,095
6. Iowa real estate commission For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes	\$173,242

Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.
