## AN ACT

RELATING TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE IOWA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT  
SYSTEM FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section ninety-seven B point forty-one (97B.41), subsection three (3), paragraph b, subparagraph four (4), Code 1975, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter fifty (50), section nine (9), is amended to read as follows:

(4) Employees hired for temporary employment of six months or less duration ~~except temporary employees of the general assembly.~~

Sec. 2. Section ninety-seven B point forty-one (97B.41), subsection three (3), paragraph b, Code 1975, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter fifty (50), sections eight (8) and nine (9), is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:

NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. Temporary employees of the general assembly of Iowa unless such employees shall make an application to the commission to be covered under the provisions of this chapter.

Sec. 3. The provisions of this Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1976.

Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Red Oak Express, a newspaper published

in Red Oak, Iowa, and in The Evening Sentinel, a newspaper published in Shenandoah, Iowa.
