1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of social services for the

AN ACT
MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
SOCIAL SERVICES FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of social services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976, the sum of thirteen million eight hundred thousand (13,800,000) dollars to be used to supplement existing appropriations for medical assistance.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kossuth County Advance, a newspaper published in Algona, Iowa, and in the Quad-City Times, a newspaper published in Davenport, Iowa.
