FISCAL NOTE

Date prepared: May 3, 1976
Requested by: Senator Priebe, Senator Taylor
Prepared in regard to: House File 1123, An Act relating to noxious weeds.

Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Joint Rule 16.

The Legislative Fiscal Bureau has received the following estimates in regard to House File 1123:

"House File 1123 will incur no additional financial cost to this Department.

Furthermore, if other state departments who hold state land are pursuing a noxious weed control program, the additional noxious weeds added by this bill will not create an additional financial cost."

Robert H. Lounsberry, Secretary of Agriculture

"It is estimated that the control of wild sunflowers on state (conservation) property would cost approximately \$100,000.00 annually."

Ken Kakac, Superintendent, Conservation Enforcement, Iowa Conservation Commission.

As evidenced by the above two fiscal estimates, opinions vary as to the fiscal effect of H.F. 1123. Because the estimates of state officials vary widely and because the enforcement of the noxious weed statute on state land also varies widely, no accurate fiscal estimate can be given.

RELATING TO NOXIOUS WEEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred seventeen point one (317.1), subsection two (2), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

2. Secondary noxious weeds, which shall include butterprint (*Abutilon theophrasti*) annual, cocklebur (*Xanthium commune*) annual, wild mustard (*Brassica arvensis*) annual, wild carrot (*Daucus carota*) biennial, buckhorn (*Plantago lanceolata*) perennial, sheep sorrel (*Rumex acetosella*) perennial, sour dock (*Rumex crispus*) perennial, smooth dock (*Rumex altissimus*) perennial, poison hemlock (*conium maculatum*), wild sunflower (wild strain of *Helianthus annus* L.) annual, puncture vine (*Tribulus terrestris*) annual, teasel (*Dipsacus*) biennial.
