2 to carry out various programs under the commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state and the funds indicated to the state conserva-  
3 tion commission and its divisions for the fiscal year begin-  
4 ning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following  
5 amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used  
6 for the following purposes:

9 1. DIVISION OF LANDS AND WATERS

10 For deposit in the state conserva-  
11 tion fund from the general fund of the  
12 state for salaries, support, mainte-  
13 nance, equipment and miscellaneous  
14 purposes of the division, maintenance  
15 of state parks, waters, and forests,  
16 prison labor programs and including  
17 not more than nine hundred seventy  
18 thousand one hundred (970,100) dol-  
19 lars which shall be available for  
20 the administration fund from the  
21 state conservation fund in compli-

20 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the marine fuel tax  
21 fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending  
22 June 30, 1977 to the state conservation commission, divi-  
23 sion of lands and waters, such amounts of funds computed as  
24 provided in section three hundred twenty-four point eighty-  
25 four (324.84) of the Code, which funds shall be deposited  
26 in the state conservation fund for use in the state conserva-  
27 tion commission recreational boating program as provided in  
28 subsections one (1) through five (5) of section three hundred  
29 twenty-four point seventy-nine (324.79) of the Code. The  
30 unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds specifically  
31 allocated for capital projects shall not revert to the fund  
32 from which appropriated until June 30, 1980.

33 Sec. 3. All receipts and refunds and reimbursements related  
34 to activities funded by the administration fund are appro-  
35 priated to the administration fund. All refunds and reim-

1 bursements relating to activities of the state fish and game  
2 protection fund shall be credited to the state fish and game  
3 protection fund.

4 Sec. 4. The transfer of funds from the state conservation  
5 fund and the state fish and game protection fund to the ad-  
6 ministration funds shall not exceed the amounts specified  
7 in subsections one (1) and two (2) of section one (1) of this  
8 Act.

9 Sec. 5. Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975  
10 Session, chapter one hundred ten (110), section sixteen (16),  
11 is amended to read as follows:

12 SEC. 16. There is appropriated from the general fund of  
13 the state to the "green thumb" fund created in section two  
14 (2) of this Act, for the fiscal years beginning July 1, ~~1974~~  
15 1975 and ending June 30, ~~1976~~ 1977, the sum of two hundred  
16 fifty thousand (250,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is  
17 necessary, to be used according to the provisions of sec-  
18 tions one (1) through five (5) of this Act.

19 Sec. 6. Funds appropriated pursuant to sections one (1),  
20 two (2), and three (3) of this Act shall be used to pay  
21 salaries and for support of not more than a total of four  
22 hundred ninety-six permanent full-time positions.

23 Sec. 7. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
24 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appro-  
25 priated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants  
26 or receipts.

27 EXPLANATION

28 Section 1 of this bill appropriates a total of \$9,913,379.  
29 Of this amount \$3,655,279 is from the general fund and  
30 \$6,258,100 is from the fish and game protection fund. This  
31 appropriation provides for increased costs due to operation  
32 of the Rathbun fish hatchery and Big Creek and Pleasant Creek  
33 State Parks. Section 5 extends the reversion date of the  
34 "Green Thumb" program for which funds were appropriated during  
35 1975. This will allow the funds to be expended over an entire  
36 work season.

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION TO CARRY OUT VARIOUS PROGRAMS UNDER THE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state and the funds indicated to the state conservation commission and its divisions for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

1. DIVISION OF LANDS AND WATERS

For deposit in the state conservation fund from the general fund of the state for salaries, support, maintenance, equipment and miscellaneous purposes of the division, maintenance of state parks, waters, and forests, prison labor programs and including not more than nine hundred seventy thousand one hundred (970,100) dollars which shall be available for the administration fund from the state conservation fund in compliance with the provisions of section one hundred seven point seventeen (107.17) of the Code ..... \$3,545,639

2. DIVISION OF FISH AND GAME

From the state fish and game protection fund for salaries, support, maintenance, equipment and miscellaneous purposes, including not more than nine hundred seventy thousand one hundred (970,100) dollars, which shall be available from the state fish and game protection fund for the administration fund in compliance with the provisions of section one hundred seven point seventeen (107.17) of the Code ..... \$6,258,100

3. STATE ADVISORY BOARD FOR PRE-SERVES

From the general fund of the state for salaries, support, maintenance, equipment and miscellaneous purposes for carrying out the duties of the board ..... \$ 24,790

4. LAND SURVEYS

From the general fund of the state for land surveys to establish and identify the boundaries to state-owned land along the Missouri and Mississippi Rivers ..... \$ 40,000

5. MISSOURI AND MISSISSIPPI RIVER BASIN COMMISSIONS

From the general fund of the state for the state's contribution for support of the Missouri and Mississippi River Basin Commissions ..... \$ 44,850

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the marine fuel tax fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 to the state conservation commission, division of lands and waters, such amounts of funds computed as provided in section three hundred twenty-four point eighty-

four (324.84) of the Code, which funds shall be deposited in the state conservation fund for use in the state conservation commission recreational boating program as provided in subsections one (1) through five (5) of section three hundred twenty-four point seventy-nine (324.79) of the Code. The unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds specifically allocated for capital projects shall not revert to the fund from which appropriated until June 30, 1980.

Sec. 3. All receipts and refunds and reimbursements related to activities funded by the administration fund are appropriated to the administration fund. All refunds and reimbursements relating to activities of the state fish and game protection fund shall be credited to the state fish and game protection fund.

Sec. 4. The transfer of funds from the state conservation fund and the state fish and game protection fund to the administration funds shall not exceed the amounts specified in subsections one (1) and two (2) of section one (1) of this Act.

Sec. 5. Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter one hundred ten (110), section sixteen (16), is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 16. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the "green thumb" fund created in section two (2) of this Act, for the fiscal years beginning July 1, ~~1974~~ 1975 and ending June 30, ~~1976~~ 1977, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand (250,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used according to the provisions of sections one (1) through five (5) of this Act.

Sec. 6. Funds appropriated pursuant to sections one (1), two (2), and three (3) of this Act shall be used to pay salaries and for support of not more than a total of four hundred ninety-six permanent full-time positions.

Sec. 7. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appro-

priated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
