A BILL FOR

1 An Act appropriating funds to the capitol planning commission
2 for a central energy plant.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the capitol planning commission the following
3 amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
4 for the purposes designated:

5 For a central energy plant
6 utilizing the two existing boil-
7 ers and adding one new boiler, a
8 new above ground three hundred
9 thousand gallon fuel oil tank and
10 for construction of an integrated
11 loop for chilled water connecting
12 all existing buildings in the
13 capitol complex..... \$3,000,000

14 Sec. 2. All unencumbered or unobligated balances of ap-
15 propriations made by this Act shall on August 31, 1980 revert
16 to the state treasury and to the credit of the fund from which
17 appropriated.

18 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
19 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
20 tion in The Woodbine Twiner, a newspaper published in Woodbine,
21 Iowa, and in The Mediapolis New Era, a newspaper published
22 in Mediapolis, Iowa.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill appropriates 3,000,000 dollars to the capitol
25 planning commission for a central energy plant including the
26 addition of one new boiler to the two existing boilers, the
27 addition of a new above ground 300,000 gallon fuel oil tank
28 and for the construction of an integrated loop for chilled
29 water linking together all existing buildings in the capitol
30 complex.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill appropriates 3,000,000 dollars to the capitol
21 planning commission for a central energy plant including the
22 addition of one new boiler to the two existing boilers, the
23 addition of a new above ground 300,000 gallon fuel oil tank
24 and for the construction of an integrated loop for chilled
25 water linking together all existing buildings in the capitol
26 complex.

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR
A CENTRAL ENERGY PLANT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the general services department the following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

For a central energy plant utilizing the two existing boilers and adding one new boiler, a new above ground three hundred thousand gallon fuel oil tank and for construction of an integrated loop for chilled water connecting all existing buildings in the capitol complex..... \$2,282,657

Sec. 2. Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter sixty-two (62), section one (1), subsection eight (8), paragraph B, unnumbered paragraph one (1), is amended to read as follows:

b. To supplement funds appropriated in chapter one thousand fifty-seven (1057), section one (1), Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1974 Session, and to provide sufficient funds for the completion of a state agricultural building to be known as the Henry A. Wallace building and to supplement funds appropriated in Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973 Session, chapter ninety-seven (97), section one (1), subsection three (3), as amended by Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1974 Session, chapter one thousand fifty-eight (1058), section one (1), to provide sufficient funds for the completion of a state office building in accordance

with plans developed, to provide for the payment of moving expenses for the occupants of the Henry A. Wallace building and the state office building and to provide that funds may be used for the construction of a radio communications tower and the matching of federal funds, providing a total cost of construction of the Henry A. Wallace building, the payment of moving expenses, and state funds used for matching of federal funds for the construction of a radio communications tower and the state office building not to exceed twenty-three million three hundred thousand (23,300,000) dollars if the contracts for construction of the Henry A. Wallace building and the state office building are awarded no later than November 1, 1975..... \$3,000,000

Sec. 3. All unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act shall on August 31, 1980 revert to the state treasury and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated.

Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Woodbine Twiner, a newspaper published in Woodbine, Iowa, and in The Mediapolis New Era, a newspaper published in Mediapolis, Iowa.
