1 WHEREAS, on January 6, 1975, the Allamakee County Grand
2 Jury recommended to the Allamakee County Board of Supervisors
3 that the windows in the Courtroom of the Allamakee County
4 Courthouse in Waukon be replaced; and

5 WHEREAS, pursuant to said recommendation of the Allam-
6 kee County Grand Jury, the Allamakee County Board of
7 Supervisors made a contract with Gary Berger Construction
8 of Waukon, for replacement of said windows at a cost of
9 \$3,527.16, said contract being entered into without complying
10 with Iowa Code Section 332.7 and 332.8 pertaining to Contracts,
11 Bids, Plans, and Specifications; and,

12 WHEREAS, in order to improve the farming efficiency,
13 production and income of the Allamakee County Farm located
14 at the Allamakee County Care Facility, the Allamakee County
15 Board of Supervisors made contracts with Gary Berger
16 Construction of Waukon for cement work and improvements to
17 the dairy barn and loafing area at a cost of \$6,283.65; with
18 Great Plains Supply Company of Waukon for repairs to the hog
19 house at a cost of \$8,724.75; and with Waukon Concrete, Inc.
20 Waukon for cement work on the hog house at a cost of \$2,654.84;
21 all of said contracts being entered into without complying
22 with Iowa Code Sections 332.7 and 332.8 pertaining to
23 Contracts, Bids, Plans and Specifications;

24 WHEREAS, the work above contracted for has been completed
25 and funds for the payment of the same are available in the
26 General Fund of Allamakee County; NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

28 Section 1. All proceedings heretofore taken by the Board
29 of Supervisors of Allamakee County, Iowa in connection with
30 and pertaining to the completion of contracts with Gary Berger
31 Construction, Waukon, Iowa; Great Plains Supply Company,
32 Waukon, Iowa; and Waukon Concrete, Inc., Waukon, Iowa, entered
33 into by said Board of Supervisors for improvements to the
34 Allamakee County Courthouse and Allamakee County Farm located
35 at the Allamakee County Care Facility, are hereby declared

1 to be legal and constitute valid and binding obligations of
2 Allamakee County, Iowa.

3 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
4 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-
5 cation in the Postville Herald, a newspaper published in
6 Postville, Iowa, and in the Waukon Democrat, a newspaper
7 published in Waukon, Iowa, without expense to the State.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill legalizes actions of the board of supervisors
10 whereby contracts were let for repairs and improvements to
11 Allamakee county courthouse upon recommendation of the
12 Allamakee county grand jury and also made improvements and
13 repairs to the Allamakee county farm without complying with
14 the provisions of sections 332.7 and 332.8 of the Code re-
15 lating to contracts, bids, plans and specifications.

AN ACT

TO LEGALIZE THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ALLAMAKEE COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH CONTRACTS MADE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY HOME AND ALLAMAKEE COUNTY COURT HOUSE.

WHEREAS, on January 6, 1975, the Allamakee County Grand Jury recommended to the Allamakee County Board of Supervisors that the windows in the Courtroom of the Allamakee County Courthouse in Waukon be replaced; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said recommendation of the Allamakee County Grand Jury, the Allamakee County Board of Supervisors made a contract with Gary Berger Construction of Waukon, for replacement of said windows at a cost of \$3,527.16, said contract being entered into without complying with Iowa Code Section 332.7 and 332.8 pertaining to Contracts, Bids, Plans, and Specifications; and,

WHEREAS, in order to improve the farming efficiency, production and income of the Allamakee County Farm located at the Allamakee County Care Facility, the Allamakee County Board of Supervisors made contracts with Gary Berger Construction of Waukon for cement work and improvements to the dairy barn and loafing area at a cost of \$6,283.65; with Great Plains Supply Company of Waukon for repairs to the hog house at a cost of \$8,724.75; and with Waukon Concrete, Inc. Waukon for cement work on the hog house at a cost of \$2,654.84; all of said contracts being entered into without complying with Iowa Code Sections 332.7 and 332.8 pertaining to Contracts, Bids, Plans and Specifications;

WHEREAS, the work above contracted for has been completed and funds for the payment of the same are available in the General Fund of Allamakee County; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. All proceedings heretofore taken by the Board of Supervisors of Allamakee County, Iowa in connection with and pertaining to the completion of contracts with Gary Berger Construction, Waukon, Iowa; Great Plains Supply Company, Waukon, Iowa; and Waukon Concrete, Inc., Waukon, Iowa, entered into by said Board of Supervisors for improvements to the Allamakee County Courthouse and Allamakee County Farm located at the Allamakee County Care Facility, are hereby declared to be legal and constitute valid and binding obligations of Allamakee County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Postville Herald, a newspaper published in Postville, Iowa, and in the Waukon Democrat, a newspaper published in Waukon, Iowa, without expense to the State.
