2 of the state to the department of agriculture for the fiscal
3 year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the
4 following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to
5 be used for the purposes designated:

22 Sec. 3. Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975
23 Session, chapter one hundred twenty-seven (127), section eight
24 (8), is amended to read as follows:

25 SEC. 8. There is appropriated from the general fund of
26 the state to the department of agriculture for the fiscal
27 year term beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976
28 1977, the sum of fifty thousand (50,000) dollars, or so much
29 thereof as may be necessary, to make grants to counties to
30 pay the indemnity and the expenses of the inspection and
31 testing of animals as provided in chapters one hundred sixty-
32 three A (163A) and one hundred sixty-four (164) of the Code.
33 The secretary of agriculture shall not approve a grant under
34 this section to a county unless the board of supervisors has
35 levied the maximum levy for the county brucellosis eradication

1 fund under section one hundred sixty-four point twenty-three
2 (164.23) of the Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
3 4975 1976 and ending June 30, 4976 1977 and all funds in the
4 county brucellosis eradication fund including all unobligated
5 funds transferred from the county tuberculosis eradication
6 fund, have been expended.

7 Sec. 4. Funds appropriated by sections one (1) and two
8 (2) of this Act to the department of agriculture shall be
9 used to pay salaries and support for not more than three
10 hundred seven permanent full-time positions.

11 Sec. 5. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
12 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are
13 appropriated for the purposes set forth in the federal grants
14 or receipts.

15 EXPLANATION

16 Section 1 appropriates a total of \$3,191,625 to the
17 department of agriculture. Section 2 appropriates funds from
18 various agricultural trust funds to the department for costs
19 incurred in carrying out statutory responsibilities relating
20 to fees collected and deposited in such trusts. There are
21 bills pending which will abolish agriculture department trust
22 funds. An alternative provision is included to provide for
23 appropriations from the general fund in place of amounts
24 appropriated from the trusts if such trusts are abolished
25 by the general assembly in 1976 and funds previously deposited
26 in the trusts are deposited in the general fund. Section
27 3 extends through June 30, 1977 the appropriation made by
28 the 1975 Session of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly to pay
29 county brucellosis eradication claims when such claims exceed
30 funds available in the county brucellosis eradication fund.

27 Sec. 3. Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975

28 Session, chapter one hundred twenty-seven (127), section eight

29 (8), is amended to read as follows:

30 SEC. 8. There is appropriated from the general fund of

31 the state to the department of agriculture for the fiscal

32 year term beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976

33 1977, the sum of fifty thousand (50,000) dollars, or so much

34 thereof as may be necessary, to make grants to counties to

35 pay the indemnity and the expenses of the inspection and

1 testing of animals as provided in chapters one hundred sixty-
2 three A (163A) and one hundred sixty-four (164) of the Code.
3 The secretary of agriculture shall not approve a grant under
4 this section to a county unless the board of supervisors has
5 levied the maximum levy for the county brucellosis eradication
6 fund under section one hundred sixty-four point twenty-three
7 (164.23) of the Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
8 4975 1976 and ending June 30, 4976 1977 and all funds in the
9 county brucellosis eradication fund including all unobligated
10 funds transferred from the county tuberculosis eradication
11 fund, have been expended.

12 Sec. 4. Funds appropriated by sections one (1) and two
13 (2) of this Act to the department of agriculture shall be
14 used to pay salaries and support for not more than three
15 hundred seven permanent full-time positions.

16 Sec. 5. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
17 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are
18 appropriated for the purposes set forth in the federal grants
19 or receipts.

20 EXPLANATION

21 Section 1 appropriates a total of \$3,191,625 to the
22 department of agriculture. Section 2 appropriates funds from
23 various agricultural trust funds to the department for costs
24 incurred in carrying out statutory responsibilities relating
25 to fees collected and deposited in such trusts. There are
26 bills pending which will abolish agriculture department trust
27 funds. An alternative provision is included to provide for
28 appropriations from the general fund in place of amounts
29 appropriated from the trusts if such trusts are abolished
30 by the general assembly in 1976 and funds previously deposited
31 in the trusts are deposited in the general fund. Section
32 3 extends through June 30, 1977 the appropriation made by
33 the 1975 Session of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly to pay
34 county brucellosis eradication claims when such claims exceed
35 funds available in the county brucellosis eradication fund.
