 3 NEW SECTION. Except as provided in section one hundred  
 4 nine point thirteen (109.13) of the Code, any game or fish  
 5 seized by the commission under section one hundred nine point  
 6 twelve (109.12) of the Code or any game accidentally killed  
 7 by a motor vehicle on a public highway shall, when practicable,  
 8 be processed for human consumption by the commission and  
 9 donated to a charitable institution.

EXPLANATION

 11 This bill provides that any game and fish confiscated by  
 12 the commission as provided by law and any game which may be  
 13 accidentally killed by a motorist shall be processed by the  
 14 commission, when practicable, and donated to charity.

RELATING TO THE DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN GAME BY THE STATE  
CONSERVATION COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred nine (109), Code 1975,  
is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. Except as provided in section one hundred  
nine point thirteen (109.13) of the Code, any game or fish  
seized by the commission under section one hundred nine point  
twelve (109.12) of the Code or any game accidentally killed  
by a motor vehicle on a public highway shall, when salvageable,  
be disposed of as determined by the commission or its  
designee.
