A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate to the department of social services
2 funds to supplement federal funds allocated to Iowa,
3 under the statute commonly referred to as title twenty
4 (XX), to pay a portion of the cost of certain local
5 human resource programs.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of social services, for the
3 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977,
4 the sum of one million (1,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof
5 as is needed, to be used by the department to match county
6 or other locally-generated public or private funds in the
7 same manner, and for the same purposes, as authorized for
8 federal funds made available to this state pursuant to United
9 States public law ninety-three dash six hundred forty-seven
10 (93-647) and regulations adopted thereunder, hereafter referred
11 to in this Act as title twenty (XX). It is the intent of
12 the general assembly that the funds appropriated by this Act
13 be used to pay up to seventy-five percent of the cost of local
14 human resource purchase-of-service arrangements and programs
15 which are being or would have been funded to the same extent
16 with title twenty (XX) money, but for which funds will not
17 in fact be available from that source due to the anticipated
18 reduction in the allocation to Iowa of federal funds available
19 under title twenty (XX). It is further the intent of the
20 general assembly that no funds appropriated by this Act be
21 used for administrative costs of the department of social
22 services.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill appropriates \$1,000,000 to the Department of
25 Social Services to be used to supplement the federal allocation
26 to Iowa under Title XX of the Social Security Act. Since
27 this federal allocation is being reduced for the coming fiscal
28 year, the state supplementation is necessary to avoid forcing
29 local planning groups to abandon some of the programs they
30 are funding or plan to fund with money received under Title
31 XX.

Amend House File 1565 as follows:

1. Page 1, by inserting after line 22 the following new sections:

"Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS. Not less than seventy-five percent of the funds made available by the federal government to this state under United States public law ninety-three dash six hundred forty-seven (93-647), hereafter referred to in this section as title twenty (XX), shall be allocated by the department of social services among the several counties of the state on the basis of the populations of the respective counties. The funds shall be used by the county board of social welfare, with approval of the county board of supervisors, to match county or locally-generated public or private funds in the manner and for the purposes authorized by title twenty (XX) and federal regulations adopted thereunder.

Not more than twenty-five percent of the funds made available to the state by the federal government pursuant to title twenty (XX) shall be retained for use directly by the department.

Sec. 3. Section two (2) of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977."

AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FUNDS
TO SUPPLEMENT FEDERAL FUNDS ALLOCATED TO IOWA, UNDER
THE STATUTE COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS TITLE TWENTY (XX),
TO PAY A PORTION OF THE COST OF CERTAIN LOCAL HUMAN RE-
SOURCE PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of social services, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977, the sum of one million (1,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is needed, to be used by the department to match county or other locally-generated public or private funds in the same manner, and for the same purposes, as authorized for federal funds made available to this state pursuant to United States public law ninety-three dash six hundred forty-seven (93-647) and regulations adopted thereunder, hereafter referred to in this Act as title twenty (XX). It is the intent of the general assembly that the funds appropriated by this Act be used to pay up to seventy-five percent of the cost of local human resource purchase-of-service arrangements and programs which are being or would have been funded to the same extent with title twenty (XX) money, but for which funds will not in fact be available from that source due to the anticipated reduction in the allocation to Iowa of federal funds available under title twenty (XX). It is further the intent of the

general assembly that no funds appropriated by this Act be used for administrative costs of the department of social services.
