AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, LAND ACQUISITION, AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASE OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC DEFENSE, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, AND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1976, to the following named agencies for the purposes indicated, the following amounts, or so much thereof as are necessary:

1. LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY

For a sewage system at the shooting range..... \$ 5,000

2. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC DEFENSE

a. For repair, replacement, alteration, equipment, and rehabilitation of national guard armory facilities throughout the state, including the maintenance and repair of equipment required for use of such facilities..... \$ 130,000

b. For repair, replacement, alteration, equipment, and rehabilitation of buildings, grounds, roads and facilities located within the Camp Dodge military reservation..... \$ 160,000

3. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

a. For radio equipment and related items pertaining to the

conversion of stations from low band to high band..... \$ 254,000

b. For land acquisition

for communication tower sites..... \$ 28,000

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the primary road fund for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1976 to the department of transportation the following amounts or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used in the manner indicated:

1. Land and improvements

for field operation facilities..... \$ 700,000

2. Ames area, to construct a

steam line from Iowa state university of science and technology..... \$1,300,000

Sec. 3. Unencumbered or unobligated funds remaining from appropriations made by this Act on June 30, 1980 shall revert to the fund from which appropriated on September 30, 1980.
