A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the department of social
2 services for capital improvement projects.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of social services for the
3 fiscal year commencing July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977
4 the sum of two million (2,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof
5 as is necessary, to be used for capital improvement projects
6 deemed necessary by the department for institutions under
7 its jurisdiction or for maintenance of such institutions.

8 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of
9 the state to the department of social services the sum of
10 four million five hundred thousand (4,500,000) dollars such
11 sum to be deposited in the hospital-schools revolving fund.
12 Funds appropriated by this section shall revert to the general
13 fund in the same manner as other funds deposited in the
14 hospital-schools revolving fund.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This Act appropriates \$2,000,000 to the department of
17 social services for the department to use as it deems necessary
18 for institutions under its jurisdiction or for the maintenance
19 of such institutions and appropriates \$4,500,000 to the
20 hospital-schools revolving fund to continue upgrading the
21 hospital-schools to meet intermediate care facilities for
22 the mentally retarded (ICFMR) certification requirements.

2 1. Page 1, line 4, by striking the words
3 "two million (2,000,000)" and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the words "two million nine hundred
5 thousand (2,900,000)".

6 2. Page 1, line 4, by inserting after the
7 word "dollars," the words "nine hundred thousand
8 of which is to be applied to the cost of con-
9 structing at the Iowa veterans home a one hundred
10 eighty bed nursing facility and for renovating
11 the Sheeler health care facility of the Iowa
12 veterans home, and the remainder,".

13 3. Page 1, by adding after line 7 the
14 following:

15 "It is the intent of the general assembly
16 that the general assembly meeting in the year
17 1977 shall appropriate an additional sum of two
18 million five hundred thousand (2,500,000) dollars
19 for completion of the projects at the Iowa
20 veterans home provided for in this section."

21 4. Page 1, by inserting after line 14 the
22 following section:

23 "Sec. _____. Unencumbered or unobligated
24 funds remaining on June 30, 1980 from funds
25 appropriated by section one (1) of this Act for
26 the projects at the Iowa veterans home shall
27 revert to the general fund of the state on
28 September 30, 1980."

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES
FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of social services for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the sum of two million nine hundred thousand (2,900,000) dollars, nine hundred thousand of which is to be applied to the cost of constructing at the Iowa veterans home a one hundred eighty bed nursing facility and for renovating the Sheeler health care facility of the Iowa veterans home, and the remainder, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for capital improvement projects deemed necessary by the department for institutions under its jurisdiction or for maintenance of such institutions.

It is the intent of the general assembly that the general assembly meeting in the year 1977 shall appropriate an additional sum of two million five hundred thousand (2,500,000) dollars for completion of the projects at the Iowa veterans home provided for in this section.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of social services the sum of four million five hundred thousand (4,500,000) dollars such sum to be deposited in the hospital-schools revolving fund. Funds appropriated by this section shall revert to the general fund in the same manner as other funds deposited in the hospital-schools revolving fund.

Sec. 3. Unencumbered or unobligated funds remaining on

June 30, 1980 from funds appropriated by section one (1) of this Act for the projects at the Iowa veterans home shall revert to the general fund of the state on September 30, 1980.
