1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-nine point twelve
2 (279.12), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new
3 unnumbered paragraph:

4 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The board may approve a policy

13 EXPLANATION

14 The bill provides that a school board may approve a policy

RELATING TO EDUCATIONAL LEAVES OF ABSENCE FOR SCHOOL

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-nine point twelve (279.12), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The board may approve a policy for educational leave for certificated school employees and for reimbursement for tuition paid by certificated school employees for courses approved by the board.
