15 of such units for the development and implementation of  
16 programs and projects for the improvement of law enforce-  
17 ment.

18 2. Any allocation of funds from funds appropriated by  
19 subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act shall be  
20 approved by the state comptroller and the governor.

21 3. All unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds  
22 appropriated by subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this  
23 Act shall on September 30, 1980 revert to the general fund  
24 of this state. All unencumbered or unobligated balances of  
25 funds appropriated by subsection four (4) of section one (1)  
26 of this Act shall revert to the general fund of the state  
27 on December 31, 1977.

28 Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the receipts of the  
29 agencies receiving funds by this Act are appropriated for  
30 the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

31 Sec. 5. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used  
32 for capital improvements.

33 EXPLANATION

34 The appropriations to the Iowa crime commission in section  
35 1, subsections 1 and 2, are intended to fund the programs

1 at the current level. The appropriation in subsection 2 will  
2 be used to attract \$7,516,000 in federal funds. Funds are  
3 provided in order that persons in the arson division who  
4 qualify may administratively be transferred to the peace  
5 officers retirement system provided for in chapter 97A of  
6 the Code. Subsection 3 allows the Iowa crime commission to  
7 evaluate the National Advisory Commission on Criminal Justice  
8 Standards and Goals and determine whether the standards and  
9 goals will serve the purposes of crime reduction and  
10 prevention. Subsection 4 is the state's required match to  
11 support the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act  
12 of 1974.

13 The appropriation to the department of public safety is  
14 to fund its program at current levels with the addition of  
15 two fire inspectors and except as otherwise specified in the  
16 bill.

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO STATE AGENCIES WITH RESPONSIBILITIES RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT INCLUDING THE IOWA CRIME COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, AND RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION AND USE OF SUCH FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the Iowa crime commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 except as provided in subsection three (3) of section four (4) of this Act, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

Sec. 3.

1. The funds appropriated by subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act constitute a portion of the federal statutory requirement to provide in the aggregate not less than one-half of the nonfederal funding for projects conducted by units of general local government or combinations of such units for the development and implementation of programs and projects for the improvement of law enforcement.

2. Any allocation of funds from funds appropriated by subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act shall be approved by the state comptroller and the governor.

3. All unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds appropriated by subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act shall on September 30, 1980 revert to the general fund of this state. All unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds appropriated by subsection four (4) of section one (1) of this Act shall revert to the general fund of the state on December 31, 1977.

Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the receipts of the agencies receiving funds by this Act are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 5. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used for capital improvements.
