1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred thirty-two (332), Code
2 1975, is amended by adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. FACILITIES FOR THE HANDICAPPED. The county
4 board of supervisors may provide facilities, including but
5 not limited to buildings, and services for mentally or
6 physically handicapped persons or both, in the form of
7 sheltered workshops or in other forms.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill authorizes the county to provide various types
10 of facilities and services for handicapped persons. Under
11 federal revenue sharing provisions, and under chapter 28E
12 joint projects, it is essential that a governmental unit have
13 clear authority in its own right to engage in projects in
14 order to use the federal funds or to join with other public
15 or private agencies to provide the facilities or services.

1 Amend House File 16 as follows:

2 1. Page 1, by inserting after line 7 the fol-
3 lowing:

4 "Sec. 2. Section three hundred forty-five point
5 one (345.1), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:
6 345.1 EXPENDITURES--WHEN VOTE NECESSARY. The
7 board of supervisors shall not order the erection
8 of, or the building of an addition or extension to,
9 or the remodeling or reconstruction or relocation
10 and replacement of a courthouse, jail, county hospital,
11 county home or any other county building or facility,
12 except as otherwise provided, when the probable cost
13 will exceed ten thousand dollars, nor the purchase
14 of real estate for county purposes exceeding ten
15 thousand dollars in value, until a proposition therefor
16 shall have been first submitted to the qualified
17 electors of the county, and voted for by a majority
18 of all persons voting for and against such proposition
19 at a general or special election, notice of the same
20 being given as in other special elections. However,
21 such proposition need not be submitted to the voters
22 if any such erection, construction, remodeling,
23 reconstruction, relocation and replacement, or purchase
24 of real estate may be accomplished from funds on hand
25 or from federal revenue-sharing funds or federal
26 matching funds and without the levy of additional
27 taxes ~~and-if-the-probable-cost-of-the-entire-project~~
28 ~~will-not-exceed-one-hundred-thousand-dollars---if~~
29 ~~a-project-should-be-determined-to-cost-in-excess-of~~
30 ~~one-hundred-thousand-dollars,-the-proposition-must~~
31 ~~be-submitted-to-the-qualified-electors-of-the-county~~
32 ~~without-regard-to-the-source-from-which-such-funds~~
33 ~~may-be-derived.--However,~~ and a proposition need not
34 be submitted to the qualified electors when a
35 relocation and replacement is made necessary by the
36 acquisition of county property for a federal or state
37 project, and the cost of the relocation does not
38 exceed the amount of the award of damages by the state
39 or federal government. When the probable project
40 cost exceeds fifty thousand dollars, the board shall
41 provide notice and hold a public hearing on the
42 project."

44 the period the words ", and removing election
45 requirements for facilities provided by the county
46 from funds on hand or federal funds".

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING COUNTIES TO PROVIDE FACILITIES AND SERVICES FOR
HANDICAPPED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter three hundred thirty-two (332), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. FACILITIES FOR THE HANDICAPPED. The county board of supervisors may provide facilities, including but not limited to buildings, and services for mentally or physically handicapped persons or both, in the form of sheltered workshops or in other forms.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Newton Daily News, a newspaper published in Newton, Iowa, and in the Quad-City Times, a newspaper published in Davenport, Iowa.
