BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter two hundred seventeen (217), Code 1975,
is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. The department is hereby authorized to expend
monies from the support allocation of the department as
reimbursement for replacement or repair of personal items
of the department's employees damaged or destroyed by clients
of the department during the employee's tour of duty. However,
the reimbursement shall not exceed seventy-five dollars for
each item. The department shall establish rules in accordance
with chapter seventeen A (17A) of the Code to carry out the
purpose of this section.
