AN ACT  
RELATING TO PUBLIC PAY TOILETS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. PAY TOILETS. No person shall make a charge or require any special device, key or slug for the use of a toilet located in a room provided for use of the public. Violation of this Act is a misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. Section one hundred seventy point thirty-four (170.34), Code 1975, is hereby repealed.
