1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
3 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 the following sums, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following
5 purposes:

6 1. Herbert Hoover Birthplace Foundation, Incorporated
7 For support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$ 2,730

8 2. Mississippi River Parkway Commission
9 For support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$ 6,000

10 3. Midwest Nuclear Compact
11 For dues to the Midwest Nuclear Compact \$10,853

12 4. Iowa American Revolution Bicentennial Commission
13 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous
14 purposes \$66,218

15 Sec. 2. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June
16 30, 1976 shall revert to the general fund of the state as
17 of September 30, 1976.

18 Sec. 3. The Herbert Hoover Birthplace Foundation
19 Incorporated, the Mississippi River Parkway Commission, the
20 Midwest Nuclear Compact, the Iowa American Revolution
21 Bicentennial Commission, the governor, and the state
22 comptroller are authorized to obtain and accept federal grants
23 to the state to be used in connection with the funds
24 appropriated in this Act and other available funds.

25 APPROPRIATION COMMITTEE REPORT

26 This bill provides for an appropriation to the Herbert
27 Hoover Birthplace Foundation Incorporated to purchase items
28 not provided by the National Park Service and is in the same
29 amount as appropriated for the 1974-75 fiscal year. This
30 bill makes an appropriation to the Mississippi Parkway
31 Commission to provide continued support to the Commission
32 with an increase of two hundred (200) dollars over the amount
33 appropriated for the 1974-75 fiscal year. This bill also
34 makes an appropriation to the Midwest Nuclear Compact to pay
35 membership dues to the Midwest Nuclear Compact. In addition

1 this bill makes an appropriation to the Iowa American
2 Revolution Bicentennial Commission with an increase of twelve
3 thousand (12,000) dollars over the appropriation for the 1974-
4 75 fiscal year to be used in part to pay the salary of an
5 additional person to meet the increased work load during the
6 bicentennial year.

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR USE OF THE HERBERT HOOVER BIRTH-
PLACE FOUNDATION, INCORPORATED, THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER
PARKWAY COMMISSION, THE MIDWEST NUCLEAR COMPACT, AND THE
IOWA AMERICAN REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and
ending June 30, 1976 the following sums, or so much thereof
as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

- 1. Herbert Hoover Birthplace Foundation, Incorporated
For support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$ 2,730
- 2. Mississippi River Parkway Commission
For support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$ 6,000
- 3. Midwest Nuclear Compact
For dues to the Midwest Nuclear Compact \$10,353
- 4. Iowa American Revolution Bicentennial Commission
For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous
purposes \$66,218

Sec. 2. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June
30, 1976 shall revert to the general fund of the state as
of September 30, 1976.

Sec. 3. The Herbert Hoover Birthplace Foundation
Incorporated, the Mississippi River Parkway Commission, the
Midwest Nuclear Compact, the Iowa American Revolution
Bicentennial Commission, the governor, and the state

comptroller are authorized to obtain and accept federal grants
to the state to be used in connection with the funds
appropriated in this Act and other available funds.
