17 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight

22 respects, the provisions of section eight point thirty-three
23 (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.

24 EXPLANATION

25 The appropriations to the boards of medical, nurse and
26 pharmacy examiners are intended to fund present programs at
27 their current levels with an allowance for inflation. However,
28 salaries are funded at present levels with no inflation
29 allowance. The Committee on Appropriations did not fund
30 the additional staff position requested by the board of medi-
31 cal examiners. However, this decision is not intended to
32 preclude any of these three examining boards from hiring
33 additional personnel if the positions can be justified to
34 the executive council and funded within the appropriation
35 contained in this Act. It is the intent of the Committee

1 on Appropriations that funds shall not be transferred into
2 these departments for the purpose of hiring additional
3 personnel.

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE TO EXAMINING BOARDS GOVERNING THE PRACTICES OF MEDICINE, NURSING AND PHARMACY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 to the following boards the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

1. Board of medical examiners. For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes:	\$97,886
2. Board of nurse examiners. For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes:	\$216,336
3. Board of pharmacy examiners. For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes:	\$173,993

Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1975 shall on August 31, 1976 revert to the general fund of the state. In all other

respects, the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.
