1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-seven point eighteen  
2 (147.18), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:  
3 147.18 DISQUALIFICATIONS. No examiner shall be an officer  
4 or member of the instructional staff of any school in which  
5 any profession regulated by this title is taught, or be  
6 connected therewith in any manner, except nurse examiners  
7 and psychology examiners. No examiner shall be connected  
8 in any manner with any wholesale or jobbing house dealing  
9 in supplies.

10 EXPLANATION

11 Subsection 7 of section 147.14 of the Code provides that  
12 one member of the board of psychology examiners be "primarily  
13 engaged in graduate teaching in psychology." The amendment  
14 proposed in this Act makes section 147.18 uniform with  
15 subsection 7 of section 147.14.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF PSYCHOLOGY EXAMINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section one hundred forty-seven point eighteen (147.18), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

147.18 DISQUALIFICATIONS. No examiner shall be an officer or member of the instructional staff of any school in which any profession regulated by this title is taught, or be connected therewith in any manner, except nurse examiners and psychology examiners. No examiners shall be connected in any manner with any wholesale or jobbing house dealing in supplies.
