33 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
34 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
35 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act,

1 except funds appropriated by paragraph b of subsection two  
2 (2) of section one (1) of this Act, for the fiscal year  
3 beginning July 1, 1975 remaining on June 30, 1976 shall revert  
4 to the general fund on August 31, 1976. In all other respects  
5 the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33)  
6 of the Code shall apply to this Act. Unencumbered or unobli-  
7 gated balances of funds appropriated by paragraph b of  
8 subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act remaining  
9 on June 30, 1978 shall revert to the general fund on September  
10 30, 1978.

11 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
12 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are  
13 appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants  
14 or receipts.

15 EXPLANATION

16 The appropriation to the Iowa Commission for the Blind  
17 is intended to fund the program at the current level with  
18 an allowance for inflation. No additions to the Commission's  
19 table of organization have been included.

20 The appropriation to the bonus board is intended to  
21 accomplish the following:

22 1. Provide funds necessary to meet eligible claims for  
23 education aid for world war orphans for the fiscal year 1975-  
24 76.

25 2. Provide funds necessary to meet eligible claims between  
26 July 1, 1975, and the application deadline of June 30, 1977,  
27 for claimants against the service compensation fund. This  
28 fund is used to make payments to veterans of the Vietnam  
29 conflict and other veterans who served in the armed forces  
30 during the time span of such conflict.

31 3. Provide funds necessary for salaries and support  
32 services for the general fund programs being administered  
33 by the bonus board. For 1975-76, the table of organization  
34 of the bonus board is being reduced from 20 employees to 9  
35 employees.

1 The appropriation to Educational Radio and Television  
2 Facility is intended to accomplish the following:

3 1. Provide sufficient funds to expand programming to all  
4 parts of Iowa which programming was previously limited to  
5 only certain parts of Iowa on a level consistent with current  
6 programming.

7 2. Provide approximately \$100,000 especially to be used  
8 for local programming efforts.

9 It is the intent of the Committee on Appropriations that  
10 funds appropriated by this Act shall not be transferred within  
11 these departments for the purpose of funding additional  
12 positions except as provided for in the transmitter section  
13 of the Educational Radio and Television Facility. The  
14 appropriation for this transmitter section provides for six  
15 new positions necessary to operate the additional transmitters  
16 across the state.

AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE FOR PROGRAMS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE IOWA COMMISSION FOR THE BLIND, THE BONUS BOARD, AND THE EDUCATIONAL RADIO AND TELEVISION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 except as provided in section two (2) of this Act, the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used by the following agencies for the purposes designated:

Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act, except funds appropriated by paragraph b of subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 remaining on June 30, 1976 shall revert to the general fund on August 31, 1976. In all other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act. Unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds appropriated by paragraph b of subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act remaining on June 30, 1978 shall revert to the general fund on September 30, 1978.

Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
