2 (297.7), subsection one (1), Code 1975, is amended to read

7 five thousand dollars, the board of directors shall consult
8 with the building consultant in the department of public
9 instruction as to the most approved plan for such building,
10 and the building consultant shall return the plan together
11 with any recommendations to the board of directors within
12 thirty days following the receipt of the plan.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill requires that the building consultant of the
15 department of public instruction make any recommendations
16 on the plans for erecting of school buildings within thirty
17 days after their receipt.

RELATING TO APPROVAL OF PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTING SCHOOL BUILD-
INGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two hundred ninety-seven point seven (297.7), subsection one (1), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

1. The provisions of sections 23.2 and 23.18 shall be applicable to the construction or repair of school buildings. Before ~~erecting~~ constructing any school building at a cost of more than five thousand dollars, the board of directors shall consult with the building consultant in the department of public instruction as to the most approved plan for such building, and the building consultant shall return the plan together with any recommendations to the board of directors within thirty days following the receipt of the plan.
