1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state the sum of seventeen thousand seven hundred eight
3 dollars and thirty-three cents (\$17,708.33), or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, to pay the expenses incurred on account
5 of the inaugural ceremonies and reception.

6 Warrants for payment of expenses authorized under this
7 Act shall be drawn in favor of the adjutant general upon the
8 filing of vouchers therefor with the state comptroller.

9 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
10 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-
11 cation in The Sigourney News-Review, a newspaper published

AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO DEFRAY EXPENSES OF THE INAUGURAL CEREMONIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of eight thousand seven hundred eight dollars and thirty-three cents (\$8,708.33), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to pay the expenses incurred on account of the inaugural ceremonies and reception.

Warrants for payment of expenses authorized under this Act shall be drawn in favor of the adjutant general upon the filing of vouchers therefor with the state comptroller.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Sigourney News-Review, a newspaper published in Sigourney, Iowa, and in The Wellman Advance, a newspaper published in Wellman, Iowa.
