A BILL FOR

1 An Act to provide that the making or delivering of a false
2 odometer statement is an offense subject to a penalty pro-
3 vided by law.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point seventy-
2 one (321.71), Code 1975, is amended by inserting after
3 subsection seven (7) the following new subsection:

4 NEW SUBSECTION. Any person who knowingly makes or de-
5 livers a false odometer statement as required by subsection
6 seven (7) of this section shall be guilty of a violation
7 of this section.

8 EXPLANATION

9 The state odometer law was amended in 1973 to comply with
10 the federal law and to provide for the acceptance of a fed-
11 eral odometer statement. A false federal odometer statement
12 is not a federal offense. This bill makes a false odometer
13 statement an offense punishable as provided in section 321.71
14 of the Code which provides a penalty of not less than a \$400
15 fine and not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment in the county
16 jail for up to 90 days, or both.

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE THAT THE MAKING OR DELIVERING OF A FALSE ODOMETER STATEMENT IS AN OFFENSE SUBJECT TO A PENALTY PROVIDED BY LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point seventy-one (321.71), Code 1975, is amended by inserting after subsection seven (7) the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. Any person who knowingly makes or delivers a false odometer statement as required by subsection seven (7) of this section shall be guilty of a violation of this section.
