1 Section 1. Section three hundred seventeen point one  
2 (317.1), subsection one (1), Code 1975, is amended to read  
3 as follows:

4 1. Primary noxious weeds, which shall include quack grass  
5 (Agropyron repens), perennial sow thistle (Sonchus arvensis),  
6 Canada thistle (Cirsium arvense), bull thistle (Cirsium  
7 lanceolatum), European morning glory or field bindweed  
8 (Convolvulus arvensis), horse nettle (Solanum carolinense),  
9 leafy spurge (Euphorbia esula), perennial pepper-grass  
10 (Lepidium draba), Russian knapweed (Centaurea repens),  
11 buckthorn (Rhamnus, not to include Rhamnus frangula,) and  
12 all other species of thistles belonging in genera of Cirsium  
13 and Carduus.

14 EXPLANATION

15 Iowa law includes all species of the genus "Rhamnus" in  
16 its designation of noxious weeds, although Rhamnus frangula,  
17 commonly known as tall hedge, is not a host of oat rust.  
18 This bill removes Rhamnus frangula from the list of noxious  
19 weeds.

AN ACT

TO REMOVE A CERTAIN SPECIES FROM THE LIST OF NOXIOUS WEEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred seventeen point one (317.1), subsection one (1), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

1. Primary noxious weeds, which shall include quack grass (Agropyron repens), perennial sow thistle (Sonchus arvensis), Canada thistle (Cirsium arvense), bull thistle (Cirsium lanceolatum), European morning glory or field bindweed (Convolvulus arvensis), horse nettle (Solanum carolinense), leafy spurge (Euphorbia esula), perennial pepper-grass (Lepidium draba), Russian knapweed (Centaurea repens), buckthorn (Rhamnus, not to include Rhamnus frangula,) and all other species of thistles belonging in genera of Cirsium and Carduus.
