1 Section 1. Section three hundred seven point eighteen
2 (307.18), subsections four (4), five (5), and six (6), Code
3 1975, are amended to read as follows:

4 4. Appoint such counsel as it deems necessary. The counsel
5 shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

6 5 a. Investigate the legality of all rates, charges,
7 tariffs, rules, regulations, and practices of all common
8 carriers and persons under the jurisdiction of the board,
9 and institute civil proceedings before the board or any proper
10 court to correct any illegality on the part of any common
11 carrier and prosecute the same to final determination.

12 6 b. Investigate the reasonableness of rates, tariffs,
13 charges, rules, regulations, and practices of all such common
14 carriers in interstate transportation when directed by the
15 board, or when in his judgment they are unlawful, prejudicial,
16 and discriminate against any city, community, business,
17 industry or citizen of the state and institute before the
18 interstate commerce commission or any other tribunal having
19 jurisdiction and prosecute to final determination any
20 proceeding growing out of such matters.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill clearly enumerates the duties of the
23 transportation regulation board and its legal counsel.

AN ACT
RELATING TO THE DUTIES OF THE COUNSEL OF THE TRANSPORTATION REGULATION BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred seven point eighteen (307.18), subsections four (4), five (5), and six (6), Code 1975, are amended to read as follows:

4. Appoint such counsel as it deems necessary. The counsel shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

5 a. Investigate the legality of all rates, charges, tariffs, rules, regulations, and practices of all common carriers and persons under the jurisdiction of the board, and institute civil proceedings before the board or any proper court to correct any illegality on the part of any common carrier and prosecute the same to final determination.

6 b. Investigate the reasonableness of rates, tariffs, charges, rules, regulations, and practices of all such common carriers in interstate transportation when directed by the board, or when in the counsel's judgment they are unlawful, prejudicial, and discriminate against any city, community, business, industry or citizen of the state and institute before the interstate commerce commission or any other tri-

bunal having jurisdiction and prosecute to final determination any proceeding growing out of such matters.
