AN ACT

TO REQUIRE CITIES TO GIVE NOTICE OF ANNEXATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-eight point twenty (368.20), subsection two (2), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

2. File with the secretary of state, the clerk of each city incorporated or involved in a boundary adjustment, and with the recorder of each county which contains a portion of any city or territory involved, copies of the proceedings including the original petition or plan and any amendments, the order of the board approving the petition or plan, proofs of service and publication of required notices, certification of the election result, and any other material deemed by the board to be of primary importance to the proceedings. Upon proper filing and expiration of time for appeal, or upon a subsequent date as provided in the proposal, the incorporation, discontinuance, or boundary adjustment is complete, except that if an appeal to any of the proceedings is pending, completion does not occur until the appeal is decided. The clerk of each city incorporated or involved in a boundary adjustment shall also file with the state department of transportation and with the city development board a copy
