1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the following departments for the fiscal year
3 beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 the following
4 amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
5 for the following purposes:

9 a. For salaries, support, mainte-
10 nance and miscellaneous purposes \$ 349,318

11 b. For governor's expense con-
12 nected with office \$ 5,000

13 2. LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

14 For the lieutenant governor's
15 compensation and expenses as pro-
16 vided in subsection two (2) of
17 section two point ten (2.10) of
18 the Code including service as a
19 member of the legislative coun-
20 cil and for per diem and expenses
21 incurred by him while performing
22 duties of the lieutenant governor
23 when the general assembly is not
24 in session, including travel,
25 postage and staff assistance \$ 62,170

26 3. OFFICE FOR PLANNING AND PRO-
27 GRAMMING

28 a. For salaries, support, mainte-
29 nance and miscellaneous purposes for
30 not to exceed forty-eight permanent
31 full-time positions funded all or in
32 part with state funds excluding the
33 state building code and municipal
34 planning assistance programs \$ 348,935

10 4. COUNCIL OF STATE GOVERNMENTS

11 For support of the council of
 12 state governments \$ 47,240

13 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 14 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appro-
 15 priated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants
 16 or receipts.

17 Sec. 3. Funds appropriated by this Act shall not be used
 18 for capital improvements.

19 EXPLANATION

20 Governor.

21 This appropriation in the amount of \$349,318 funds 21
 22 positions on the current table of organization. The break-
 23 down of the appropriation is as follows: salaries, \$294,518;
 24 travel, \$10,000; office supplies and expense, \$31,550; tele-
 25 phone, \$11,750; and equipment, \$1,500. An additional \$5,000
 26 is appropriated for expense connected with the office of gov-
 27 ernor.

28 Lieutenant Governor.

29 This appropriation in the amount of \$62,170 funds the 3
 30 full-time positions on the current table of organization plus
 31 funds for a legal intern to work during the legislative
 32 session.

33 Office for Planning and Programming.

34 The appropriation of \$348,935 in paragraph a of subsec-
 35 tion 3 provides state funds for the following programs:

1 administration, HUD planning, Iowa comprehensive conference,
2 city development board, local government personnel service
3 center, comprehensive health planning, human resource research,
4 governor's youth opportunity program administration, youth
5 services assistance and youth conservation corps.

6 Paragraph b provides \$123,890 for the administration of
7 the state building code. This seven member board currently
8 has a staff of four professionals and one clerical position
9 and anticipates federal funds for the addition of two posi-
10 tions. Section 103A.23 of the Code provides that fees be
11 established by rule to defray the costs of administering this
12 program. All fees are deposited in the general fund of the
13 state. Fees collected in fiscal year 1974 were \$137,474.

14 Paragraph c provides \$25,000 for municipal planning as-
15 sistance. This is a continuing program and all expenditures
16 are charged to professional and scientific services.

17 Council of State Governments.

18 This appropriation in the amount of \$47,240 provides funds
19 for Iowa's participation in the council of state governments
20 in the amount of \$27,130 and the national conference of state
21 legislatures in the amount of \$20,110.

1 Amend House File 889, as passed by the House, as
2 follows:

3 1. Page 1, by inserting after line 12 the
4 following:

5 "c. For the salaries, support, and
6 maintenance of a state information and
7 liaison office as provided in sections
8 two (2), three (3) and four (4) of
9 this Act.....\$50,000"

10 2. Page 2, by inserting after line 12, the
11 following:

12 "Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. STATE INFORMATION AND
13 LIAISON OFFICE CREATED. There is created a state
14 information and liaison office located in Washington,
15 D.C. The purpose of this office shall be to advise
16 the governor, members of the general assembly, the
17 judicial branch of government and the agencies of
18 the state and its political subdivisions of federal
19 action affecting them and to keep the various branches
20 of the federal government informed of the interests
21 of this state.

22 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. DIRECTOR APPOINTED--
23 QUALIFICATIONS. The governor shall, with the approval
24 of the senate, appoint a director of the state
25 information and liaison office. The director shall
26 serve at the pleasure of the governor and shall employ
27 necessary staff for the office. The director and
28 his staff shall be politically nonpartisan and shall
29 not participate in any partisan political activities.

30 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. DUTIES. The duties of the
31 director shall be:

- 32 1. To cooperate with members of the Iowa
- 33 congressional delegation.
- 34 2. To assist and advise the governor, members
- 35 of the general assembly, members of the judiciary
- 36 and agencies of the state and its political
- 37 subdivisions in developing sources of federal funds.
- 38 3. To assist and advise the agencies of the state
- 39 and its political subdivisions in representing their
- 40 interests before the federal government and its
- 41 agencies.
- 42 4. To cooperate with the office of programming
- 43 and planning in operating as a clearinghouse for state
- 44 applications for federal funds..
- 45 5. To perform other services and duties to aid
- 46 the state and its political subdivisions to become
- 47 knowledgeable about and be represented before agencies
- 48 of the federal government.
- 49 6. To file a copy of any report or information
- 50 from the office of state information and liaison with

3 3. Page 2, line 13, by striking the number "2"
4 and inserting in lieu thereof the number "5".

5 4. Page 2, line 17, by striking the number "3"
6 and inserting in lieu thereof the number "6".

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, OFFICE FOR PLANNING AND PROGRAMMING AND THE COUNCIL OF STATE GOVERNMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the following departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:
