1 Section 1. Section two hundred eighty A point twenty-three
2 (280A.23), subsection nine (9), Code 1975, is amended by
3 striking the subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the
4 following:

5 9. Set the salary of the area superintendent. In set-
6 ting the salary, the board shall consider the salaries of
7 administrators of educational institutions in the merged area
8 and the enrollment of the area school.

9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill grants the board of directors of a merged area
11 the authority to set the salary of the area school superin-
12 tendent.

12 of all federal and state laws, including rules pro-
13 mulgated under them.
14 b. Provides for affirmative action in hiring
15 for administrative positions.
