AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO MISCELLANEOUS STATE AGENCIES INCLUDING THE COMMITTEE ON THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE HANDICAPPED, THE IOWA HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY, THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS, THE BOARD OF NURSE EXAMINERS, THE BOARD OF PAROLE, THE BOARD OF PHARMACY EXAMINERS, THE SPANISH-AMERICAN WAR VETERANS AND THE COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the following agencies for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary to be used for the purposes designated:

Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies receiving funds under this Act are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 3. It is the intent of the general assembly in making the appropriation to the Spanish-American war veterans in subsection seven (7) of section one (1) of this Act that the department of general services supply the Spanish-American war veterans with an appropriate surplus state desk. It is also the intent of the general assembly that the agencies receiving funds under section one (1) of this Act shall use surplus state equipment to the maximum extent possible.
