7 funds for a legal intern to work during the legislative
8 session.

9 Council of State Governments.

10 This appropriation in the amount of \$49,360 provides funds
11 for Iowa's participation in the council of state governments
12 in the amount of \$27,130 and the national conference of state
13 legislatures in the amount of \$22,230.

 APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, AND
 THE COUNCIL OF STATE GOVERNMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the following departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

1. GOVERNOR	
a. For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes	\$ 388,030
b. For governor's expense connected with office	\$ 5,000
2. LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR	
For the lieutenant governor's compensation and expenses as provided in subsection two (2) of section two point ten (2.10) of the Code including service as a member of the legislative council and for per diem and expenses incurred by him while performing duties of the lieutenant governor when the general assembly is not in session, including travel, postage and staff assistance	\$ 66,930
3. COUNCIL OF STATE GOVERNMENTS	
For support of the council of state governments	\$ 49,360

Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
