1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the following agencies the following amounts
3 or so much thereof as is necessary, for the fiscal year desig-
4 nated to be used in the manner designated:

23 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
24 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are
25 appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants
26 or receipts.

27 EXPLANATION

28 Employment Security Commission

29 This appropriation funds the administration of the following
30 responsibilities assigned to the employment security commis-
31 sion:

32 Securing of quarterly wage reports for social security
33 coverage of about 170,000 public employees from 2,950 political
34 subdivisions and submitting such wage reports and contributions
35 to H.E.W.

1 Provides for administering teacher retirement pension pay-
2 ments to eligible teachers who retired from teaching prior
3 to July 1, 1953. There were 344 recipients December 31, 1974
4 and 313 as of December 31, 1975.

5 When the Iowa old age and survivors insurance system Act
6 was repealed in 1953, rights were preserved for all members
7 fully insured as of June 30, 1953 who were not in public
8 employment as of that date. Currently, benefits are being
9 paid to approximately 1408 recipients. This appropriation
10 also funds the administration of this program.

11 The number of authorized positions remains the same as
12 the current table of organization.

13 Industrial Commissioner

14 The appropriation of \$297,490 funds the current programs
15 of the office and adds a claims examiner and a part-time
16 secretary to the current table of organization.

17 Public Employment Relations Board

18 The appropriation of \$449,546 provides funding for the
19 current table of organization with no new positions authorized.
20 Included in this appropriation is \$39,000 to be used to hire
21 mediators to handle the increased work load in the area of
22 mediation. This appropriation is based on the department's
23 anticipated work load and the committee feels this agency
24 should be funded adequately to meet that work load.

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE FINANCING OF PROGRAMS UNDER THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE IOWA EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION, THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSIONER, AND THE PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the following agencies the following amounts or so much thereof as is necessary, for the fiscal year designated to be used in the manner designated:

1. IOWA EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION

For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes for the administration of chapter ninety-seven (97) and chapter ninety-seven C (97C) and section two hundred ninety-four point fifteen (294.15) of the Code \$109,002

2. INDUSTRIAL COMMISSIONER

For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$297,490

3. PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS BOARD

For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$449,546

Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are

appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
