12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill deletes the requirement that livestock be reported
14 on assessors' abstracts of property submitted to the Department
15 of Revenue. As the property tax on livestock was repealed,
16 the reporting requirement is obsolete. The bill also deletes
17 the requirement that property subject to taxation of moneys
18 and credits be reported, since the chapter of the Code dealing
19 with the taxation of moneys and credits was repealed.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section four hundred forty-one point forty-five (441.45), subsection four (4), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

other Other facts as may be required by the director of revenue.

Sec. 2. Section four hundred forty-one point forty-five (441.45), Code 1975, is amended by striking subsection five (5).
