1 Section 1. Section three hundred forty-one A point seven  
2 (341A.7), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 341A.7 CLASSIFICATIONS. The classified civil service  
4 positions covered by this chapter shall include persons  
5 actually serving as deputy sheriffs who are salaried pursuant  
6 to section 340.8, but do not include a chief deputy sheriff,  
7 two second deputy sheriffs in counties with a population of  
8 more than one hundred thousand, and four second deputy sheriffs  
9 in counties with a population of more than two hundred  
10 thousand. A deputy sheriff serving with permanent rank under  
11 this chapter may be designated chief deputy sheriff or second  
12 deputy sheriff and retain such rank during the period of his  
13 service as chief deputy sheriff or second deputy sheriff and  
14 shall, upon termination of his duties as chief deputy sheriff  
15 or second deputy sheriff, revert to his permanent rank.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill allows second deputy sheriffs to retain rights  
18 earned under the civil service for deputy county sheriffs.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS OF SECOND DEPUTY SHERIFFS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred forty-one A point seven (341A.7), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

341A.7 CLASSIFICATIONS. The classified civil service positions covered by this chapter shall include persons actually serving as deputy sheriffs who are salaried pursuant to section 340.8, but do not include a chief deputy sheriff, two second deputy sheriffs in counties with a population of more than one hundred thousand, and four second deputy sheriffs in counties with a population of more than two hundred thousand. A deputy sheriff serving with permanent rank under this chapter may be designated chief deputy sheriff or second deputy sheriff and retain such rank during the period of his service as chief deputy sheriff or second deputy sheriff and shall, upon termination of his duties as chief deputy sheriff or second deputy sheriff, revert to his permanent rank.
