2 of the women's reformatory, men's reformatory, and state  
3 penitentiary with clothing, money, and transportation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred forty-five point fourteen  
2 (245.14), Code 1975, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-sixth  
3 General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter one hundred forty-

6 245.14 CLOTHING, MONEY, AND TRANSPORTATION. When an  
7 inmate is discharged, paroled, or placed on work release when

10 at state expense, transportation to the place in this state

16 (247.16), Code 1975, is repealed.

17 EXPLANATION

18 The bill provides for the payment of fifty dollars to those  
19 inmates placed on work release when they pay a substantial  
20 part of their living expenses and for an additional fifty  
21 dollar payment for those inmates going from an educational  
22 work release to parole. Such inmates will not be eligible  
23 for the one hundred dollar payment upon parole or discharge.  
24 Transportation is provided to the place indicated in the  
25 inmate's parole, discharge, or work release plans. Presently  
26 transportation is provided to the place of the inmate's choice.

## AN ACT

RELATING TO PROVIDING DISCHARGED AND PAROLED INMATES OF THE WOMEN'S REFORMATORY, MEN'S REFORMATORY, AND STATE PENITENTIARY WITH CLOTHING, MONEY, AND TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two hundred forty-five point fourteen (245.14), Code 1975, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter one hundred forty-six (146), section one (1), is further amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

245.14 CLOTHING, MONEY, AND TRANSPORTATION. When an inmate is discharged, paroled, or placed on work release, the warden or superintendent shall furnish her, at state expense, appropriate clothing and transportation to the place in this state indicated in the inmate's discharge, parole, or work release plan. When an inmate is discharged, paroled, or placed on work release, the warden or superintendent shall provide her, at state expense, money in accordance with the following schedule:

1. Upon discharge or parole, one hundred dollars.
2. Upon being placed on work release, fifty dollars.
3. Upon going from an educational work release to parole or discharge, fifty dollars.

Those inmates receiving payment under subsections two (2) or three (3) of this section shall not be eligible for payment under subsection one (1) of this section unless they are returned to the institution. The superintendent shall maintain an account of all funds expended pursuant to this section.

Sec. 2. Section two hundred forty-six point forty-four (246.44), Code 1975, as amended by the Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter one hundred forty-

six (146), section two (2), is further amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

246.44 CLOTHING, TRANSPORTATION AND MONEY. When an inmate is discharged, paroled, or placed on work release, the warden or superintendent shall furnish him, at state expense, appropriate clothing and transportation to the place in this state indicated in the inmate's discharge, parole, or work release plan. When an inmate is discharged, paroled or placed on work release, the warden or superintendent shall provide him, at state expense, money in accordance with the following schedule:

1. Upon discharge or parole, one hundred dollars.
2. Upon being placed on work release, fifty dollars.
3. Upon going from an educational work release to parole or discharge, fifty dollars.

Those inmates receiving payment under subsections two (2) or three (3) of this section shall not be eligible for payment under subsection one (1) of this section unless they are returned to the institution. The warden or superintendent shall maintain an account of all funds expended pursuant to this section.

Sec. 3. Section two hundred forty-seven point sixteen (247.16), Code 1975, is repealed.
