1 Section 1. Section nineteen point ten (19.10), Code 1975,
 2 is amended to read as follows:
 3 19.10 COURT COSTS. The executive council may pay, out
 4 of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated,
 5 any-expense expenses incurred, or costs taxed to the state,
 6 in any proceeding brought by or against any of the state
 7 departments or in which the state is a party or is interested.
 8 This section shall not be construed to authorize the payment
 9 of travel or other personal expenses of state officers or
 10 employees.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill clarifies the law relating to payment by the
 13 executive council of court costs and expenses by disallowing
 14 any payment for travel and similar expenses. All travel and
 15 related expenses are to be charged against funds appropriated
 16 for that purpose.

RELATING TO PAYMENT BY THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF COURT RE-
LATED COSTS AND EXPENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section nineteen point ten (19.10), Code 1975,
is amended to read as follows:

19.10 COURT COSTS. The executive council may pay, out
of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated,
~~any-expense~~ expenses incurred, or costs taxed to the state,
in any proceeding brought by or against any of the state
departments or in which the state is a party or is interested.
This section shall not be construed to authorize the payment
of travel or other personal expenses of state officers or
employees.
