1 Section 1. Section two point ten (2.10), subsection two
2 (2), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 2. The lieutenant governor shall receive an annual salary
4 of twelve thousand dollars. Personal expense and travel
5 allowances shall be the same for the lieutenant governor as
6 for a senator.

7 The lieutenant governor while performing administrative
8 duties of the office of lieutenant governor when the general
9 assembly is not in session or serving as the president of
10 the senate during special sessions of the general assembly
11 shall receive sixty dollars per diem and reimbursement for
12 expenses incurred in performing such duties ~~pursuant-to-the~~

14 The salary, per diem, and expenses of the lieutenant
15 governor provided for under this subsection, including office
16 and staff expenses, shall be paid from funds appropriated
17 to the office of the lieutenant governor by the general
18 assembly.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill provides that all expenses, per diem, and salaries
21 of the lieutenant governor and his staff shall be paid from
22 funds appropriated to the office of the lieutenant governor
23 by the general assembly.

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR'S SALARY
AND EXPENSES FROM FUNDS SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED TO THE
OFFICE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two point ten (2.10), subsection two
(2), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

2. The lieutenant governor shall receive an annual salary
of twelve thousand dollars. Personal expense and travel
allowances shall be the same for the lieutenant governor as
for a senator.

The lieutenant governor while performing administrative
duties of the office of lieutenant governor when the general
assembly is not in session or serving as the president of
the senate during special sessions of the general assembly
shall receive sixty dollars per diem and reimbursement for
expenses incurred in performing such duties ~~pursuant to the
appropriation made by the general assembly.~~

The salary, per diem, and expenses of the lieutenant
governor provided for under this subsection, including office

and staff expenses, shall be paid from funds appropriated
to the office of the lieutenant governor by the general
assembly.
