A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to hearing procedures by the insurance
2 commissioner.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
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1 Section 1. Section five hundred fifteen A point eighteen
2 (515A.18), subsection one (1), Code 1975, is amended to read
3 as follows:

4 1. Any person, insurer or rating organization to which
5 the commissioner has directed an order made without a hearing
6 may, within thirty days after notice to it of such order,
7 make written request to the commissioner for a hearing thereon.
8 The commissioner shall hear such party or parties within
9 twenty days after receipt of such request and shall give not
10 less than ten days' written notice of the time and place of
11 the hearing. Within fifteen days after such hearing the
12 commissioner shall affirm, reverse or modify his previous
13 action, specifying his reasons therefor. Pending such hearing
14 and decision thereon the commissioner may suspend or postpone
15 the effective date of his previous action.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill allows an insured to appeal an order of the insurance
18 commissioner as well as an insurer or rating organization.
