### A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for the financing of library services by  
2 revising the taxing authority for library maintenance  
3 purposes and making an appropriation to the Iowa library  
4 department.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

12 EXPLANATION

13 Iowa Library Department. The sum of \$149,947 is appro-  
14 priated to the law library division to provide funding to  
15 maintain current programs. No new positions have been  
16 authorized.

17 The sum of \$93,116 is appropriated to the medical library  
18 division to fund the current T.O. of six positions.

19 The state library commission was appropriated the sum of  
20 \$291,245 which funds the current table of organization and  
21 the current programs of the commission.

22 This bill includes an appropriation of \$643,382 for state  
23 aid for the regional library system. Federal funds are  
24 anticipated to be approximately \$216,000. It is the  
25 legislative intent to replace federal funds with state funds  
26 if federal funding for the regional library program is not  
27 appropriated by the federal government, or otherwise not  
28 available to the state by reason of federal executive action  
29 during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976.

30 This bill also provides that commencing July 1, 1977, each  
31 city and county shall levy a tax of at least six and three-  
32 fourths cents per thousand dollars of assessed value on all  
33 tax property within their respective incorporated or  
34 unincorporated areas or provide an equivalent amount of funding  
35 for the purpose of providing financial support of the public

We, the undersigned members of the first conference committee appointed to consider the differences between the Senate and the House of Representatives on Senate File 1191, a bill for an Act providing for the financing of library services by revising the taxing authority for library maintenance purposes and making an appropriation to the Iowa library department, respectfully make the following report:

1. That the Senate recede from its amendment H-6691 to the House amendment S-5737 to Senate File 1191 and that the House amendment S-5737 be amended as follows:

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE FINANCING OF LIBRARY SERVICES BY REVISING THE TAXING AUTHORITY FOR LIBRARY MAINTENANCE PURPOSES AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE IOWA LIBRARY DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the Iowa library department, including the state regional library system, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976, and ending June 30, 1977, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

IOWA LIBRARY DEPARTMENT

- 1. Law library division:  
For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$149,947
- 2. Medical library division:  
For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$ 93,116
- 3. State library commission:  
For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$291,245
- 4. Regional library system:  
For state aid except as provided in this subsection.....\$666,132

The general assembly anticipates that federal funds will be available to the regional library system in an amount approximating two hundred sixteen thousand (216,000) dollars. However, if such federal funds do not become available, it is the intent of the general assembly that it will appropriate an amount of funds to replace those funds anticipated that do not become available during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976.

Sec. 2. Section three hundred three B point nine (303B.9), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

303B.9 LOCAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT. A regional board shall have the authority to require as a condition for receiving services under section 303B.6 that a governmental subdivision maintain any millage tax levy for library maintenance purposes that is in effect on July 1, 1973, ~~and that commencing~~. Commencing July 1, 1977, a public library receiving services under said section shall be funded by the local governmental subdivision through a each city within its corporate boundaries and each county within the unincorporated area of the county shall levy a tax of at least one-quarter-mill six and three-fourths cents per thousand dollars of assessed value on the taxable property or at least the monetary equivalent of one-quarter-mill six and three-fourths cents per thousand dollars of assessed value when all or a portion of the funds are obtained from a source other than taxation, for the purpose of providing financial support to the public library which provides library services within the respective jurisdictions.

Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 4. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used for capital improvements.
