A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to and making an appropriation for the
2 administration of the Iowa law enforcement academy.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the Iowa law enforcement academy for the
3 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977,
4 the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary,
5 for the purposes designated:

10 Sec. 2. Chapter eighty B (80B), Code 1975, is amended
11 by adding the following new section:

12 NEW SECTION. The academy shall be the principal law
13 enforcement library and media resource center in the state
14 and shall have jurisdiction over other law enforcement
15 libraries and media resources located in certified law
16 enforcement training schools in the state. The academy shall
17 not offer state assistance to any area school which offers
18 law enforcement education unless the area school enters into
19 an agreement with the academy concluded pursuant to the
20 provisions of chapter twenty-eight E (28E) of the Code
21 providing for efficient statewide utilization of law
22 enforcement libraries and media resources. The agreement
23 shall include provisions relating to the allocation of the
24 costs involved in administering the agreement and the benefits
25 derived to each party from the agreement.

26 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the receipts of the
27 agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated for
28 the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

29 Sec. 4. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used
30 for capital improvements.

31 EXPLANATION

32 This bill funds the Iowa law enforcement academy at the
33 current level except the funds for one librarian and one
34 multi-media instructor are included within the appropriation.

35 Section 2 establishes the Iowa law enforcement academy

1 as the principal law enforcement library and media center
2 in the state and provides for agreements between the academy
3 and certain area schools to encourage effective statewide
4 utilization of libraries and media resources.

AN ACT

RELATING TO AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE IOWA LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the Iowa law enforcement academy for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 and ending June 30, 1977, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the purposes designated:

For salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes.....\$ 464,000

Sec. 2. Chapter eighty B (80B), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. The academy shall be the principal law enforcement library and media resource center and shall coordinate the use of law enforcement media resources with training centers and educational institutions offering a two-year program in law enforcement to insure for the efficient use of state law enforcement media resources.

The academy shall offer state media resource assistance to any law enforcement training center certified by the Iowa law enforcement academy council.

Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the receipts of the agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 4. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used for capital improvements.
