22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill corrects a reference error in the social gambling  
24 bill enacted by the 1976 Session of the Iowa General Assembly.  
25 The text in Senate File 1102 is taken from chapter 99, not  
26 99B. The confusion resulted because chapter 99 of the Session  
27 laws was amending chapter 99B of the Code. The intent of  
28 the General Assembly appears clear since the text from chapter  
29 99B is set forth in the Act, however in order not to leave  
30 any doubts this Act makes the technical correction to  
31 complement the passage of Senate File 1102.
