A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the availability of mine maps.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred five point fourteen
2 (305.14), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 305.14 MAPS PROPERTY OF STATE--CUSTODY--COPIES. The maps
4 so delivered to the state geologist shall be the property
5 of the state and shall remain in the custody of the state
6 geologist. They shall be kept at the office of the geological
7 survey and be open to examination by all persons interested
8 in the same maps; but such examination shall only be made
9 in the presence of the state geologist or ~~his~~ a designee,
10 and he the state geologist shall not permit any copies of
11 the same maps to be made without the written consent of the
12 operator or the owner of the property, except as provided
13 in section 305.12 or if the mine has been abandoned for at
14 least five years.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill allows the copying of mine maps on file with
17 the geological survey without the written consent of the
18 operator or owner of the property if the mine has been
19 abandoned for at least five years.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AVAILABILITY OF MINE MAPS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred five point fourteen (305.14), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

305.14 MAPS PROPERTY OF STATE--CUSTODY--COPIES. The maps so delivered to the state geologist shall be the property of the state and shall remain in the custody of the state geologist. They shall be kept at the office of the geological survey and be open to examination by all persons interested in the same maps; but such examination shall only be made in the presence of the state geologist or ~~his~~ a designee, and ~~he~~ the state geologist shall not permit any copies of the same maps to be made without the written consent of the operator or the owner of the property, except as provided in section 305.12 or if the mine has been abandoned for at least five years.
