1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state the sum of one million five hundred thousand
3 (1,500,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, for
4 deposit in the service compensation fund administered under
5 the provisions of chapter thirty-five C (35C) of the Code,
6 to be used in the manner provided in chapter thirty-five C
7 (35C) of the Code.

8 Sec. 2. Funds appropriated by this Act are in addition
9 to any other funds appropriated by the general assembly for
10 such purposes. Unencumbered funds appropriated by this Act
11 which are available on June 30, 1978 shall on that date revert
12 to the general fund of the state.

13 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
14 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
15 tion in The Bloomfield Democrat, a newspaper published in
16 Bloomfield, Iowa, and in The Chariton Leader, a newspaper
17 published in Chariton, Iowa.

19 The recommendation for \$1,500,000 to be appropriated is
20 to meet current unpaid claims which have been approved to
21 date plus a sufficient amount to meet anticipated claims
22 through June 30, 1975. Any unused funds from this
23 appropriation will be carried forward to the fiscal year 1975-
24 76. To date, \$31,000,000 has been appropriated to this fund
25 and an additional \$1,500,000 has been transferred to the fund
26 by the Comptrollers Office. An estimated additional \$2,000,000
27 will be needed to meet the obligations of the Act creating
28 the need for this funding between July 1, 1975, and the
29 application deadline of June 30, 1977.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of one million five hundred thousand (1,500,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, for deposit in the service compensation fund administered under the provisions of chapter thirty-five C (35C) of the Code, to be used in the manner provided in chapter thirty-five C (35C) of the Code.
