This bill appropriates funds for claims filed against the state which were referred to the general assembly by the state appeal board. Section 25.3 of the Code provides for the state appeal board to file with the general assembly a list of all claims rejected by the state appeal board and other information. This bill represents the action of the claims committee of the House and Senate in approving such claims.

AN ACT

TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND AND REIMBURSEMENT FUND OF THE STATE TO CERTAIN PERSONS IN SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS MADE AGAINST THE STATE OF IOWA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund and reimbursement fund of the state to the following persons the amount set opposite their respective names in full settlement of all claims which they may have against the state of Iowa:

The remainder of the claims listed in section one (1) of this Act shall be paid from the general fund of the state.
