1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1),
2 lines sixty-four (64) and sixty-five (65), Code 1975, are
3 amended as follows:

6 Sec. 2. Chapter one hundred ten (110), Code 1975, is
7 amended by adding the following new section:

8 NEW SECTION. NONRESIDENT TRAPPING LICENSE--RECIPROCITY.

9 The commission shall issue a trapping license to a nonresi-
10 dent or alien under the same conditions and upon payment of
11 the same fee as if he were a legal resident of this state
12 if the state in which such nonresident or alien is a resident
13 reciprocates by issuing a trapping license to any legal
14 resident of this state under the same conditions and payment
15 of the same fee as if he were a legal resident of such other
16 state.

17 Sec. 3. The provisions of this Act relating to the fee
18 for nonresident or alien trapping licenses and the provisions
19 of section two (2) of this Act shall be retroactive to January
20 1, 1975. Any fees collected during calendar year 1975 for
21 nonresident or alien trapping licenses shall be refunded to
22 the licensee and the licenses shall be canceled.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill authorizes the issuance of trapping licenses
25 to nonresidents or aliens under the conditions as if they
26 were legal residents of Iowa if the state in which they are
27 residents provides legal residents of Iowa a license under
28 the same conditions as if they were legal residents of such
29 other state.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF TRAPPING LICENSES TO ALIENS OR
NONRESIDENTS AND MAKING PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT RETROACTIVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred ten (110), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. NONRESIDENT TRAPPING LICENSE--RECIPROCALITY.
All fees collected prior to the effective date of this Act for nonresident or alien trapping licenses for the year 1975 shall be refunded and the licenses shall be cancelled. Beginning on the effective date of this Act, nonresident or alien licenses may be issued only to residents of states which sell similar licenses to residents of Iowa.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Allamakee Journal, a newspaper published in Lansing, Iowa, and in The Bellevue Herald-Leader, a newspaper published in Bellevue, Iowa.
