24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill strikes the specific dollar amounts that specified
26 political subdivisions of the state would receive from the
27 sewage works treatment construction fund under Acts of the
28 Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1974 Session, Chapter 1072 and
29 extends the reversion date for such appropriation to June
30 30, 1978. The appropriation is to be used to provide an
31 amount equal to five percent of the eligible costs of eligible
32 sewage treatment works projects.




