1 Section 1. Section eighteen point seventy-five (18.75),
2 subsection nine (9), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 9. Annually, September ± first, cause to be printed a
4 report in pamphlet form, to be paid for out of the general
5 fund not otherwise appropriated, and ~~gratuitously~~ distributed
6 upon request, the name, residence, official title, salary
7 received during the previous fiscal year, the base salary
8 as computed on July first of the current fiscal year, and
9 traveling and subsistence expense of the personnel of each
10 of the departments, boards, and commissions of the state
11 government, except personnel who receive an annual salary
12 of less than three hundred dollars. The number of the
13 personnel and the total amount received by them shall be shown
14 for each department in the salary book. The head of each
15 department, board, or commission shall, on request of the
16 superintendent, furnish the latter with the data covering
17 the particular department, board, or commission. The report
18 shall be ~~mailed~~ distributed upon request without charge to
19 each member of the general assembly ~~within-ten-days-after~~
20 printing, elected state officers, and department heads. Any
21 other person who wants a report may purchase a copy for five
22 dollars per copy. All employees who have drawn salaries,
23 fees, or expense allowances from more than one department
24 or subdivision shall be listed separately under the proper
25 departmental heading.

26 EXPLANATION

27 This bill redefines the information which is required to
28 be printed in the report commonly known as the state salary
29 book. The bill provides that only those legislators, elected
30 state officers, and department heads who request a copy shall
31 receive it at no cost. Other persons who desire a copy would
32 be able to obtain one at a cost of five dollars per copy.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REPORT COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE STATE SALARY BOOK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section eighteen point seventy-five (18.75), subsection nine (9), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

9. Annually, September ~~±~~ first, cause to be printed a report in pamphlet form, to be paid for out of the general fund not otherwise appropriated, and ~~gratuitously~~ distributed upon request, the name, residence, official title, salary received during the previous fiscal year, the base salary as computed on July first of the current fiscal year, and traveling and subsistence expense of the personnel of each of the departments, boards, and commissions of the state government, except personnel who receive an annual salary of less than three hundred dollars. The number of the personnel and the total amount received by them shall be shown for each department in the salary book. The head of each department, board, or commission shall, on request of the superintendent, furnish the latter with the data covering the particular department, board, or commission. The report shall be ~~mailed~~ distributed upon request without charge to each member of the general assembly ~~within-ten-days-after~~ printing, elected state officers, and department heads. Any other person who wants a report may purchase a copy for five dollars per copy. All funds from the sale of the report shall be deposited to the general fund. All employees who have drawn salaries, fees, or expense allowances from more than one
